



This hearty dish is the perfect introduction to the region's rich seafood culture.

In the afternoon, we'll board our private cruise to explore the bay's awe-inspiring landscapes up close. As we glide through the emerald waters, you'll have time to relax on deck, take in the mesmerizing scenery, and perhaps even snap a few photos of the iconic towering limestone formations that rise dramatically from the sea. We'll also explore some of Halong Bay's hidden limestone caves, where the natural beauty will leave you speechless as the sun casts its warm glow over the bay at sunset.

Following a morning of history, we'll visit two of Hue's most famous Mausoleums -Minh Mang and Tu Duc. Set against lush landscapes, these monumental tombs offer a glimpse into the opulence of Vietnam's former emperors, with stunning architecture and serene surroundings that invite reflection and exploration.







As the day winds down, we'll embark on a private boat tour along the Huong River (Perfume River), where you can sit back and enjoy the peaceful surroundings. Onboard, sip a cold drink or perhaps try a Huda beer, brewed from the very waters you're cruising on. The scenic views of the riverbanks, dotted with pagodas and ancient tombs, will provide a tranquil backdrop for your journey.

We'll conclude the day with a traditional Hue dinner at a charming riverside restaurant, where you'll savour rich, flavourful dishes like Bánh Khoái and Nem Lui (grilled pork skewers). For the wildlife people, watch the for Asian Green Bee-eaters as they flick from perch to perch and listen out for the beautiful musical fluty song of the Lesser Necklaced Laughingthrush!

Following our exploration of the Marble Mountains, we'll enjoy a delicious lunch at a beachfront restaurant on My Khe Beach, where you can relax and take in the breathtaking views of the Son Tra Peninsula, with the iconic Lady Buddha statue shimmering over the sparkling ocean. After lunch, we'll transfer to Hoi An and check in to your hotel.

The evening is yours to explore Hoi An Ancient Town, our second UNESCO World Heritage site in 24hrs. As the sun sets, enjoy a lantern-lit walk through the charming streets, where the soft glow of lanterns creates a magical atmosphere. Dinner is not included tonight, so you're free to choose from the dozens of delightful restaurants and street food vendors offering traditional Hoi An dishes. Don't forget to try Chè for dessert - a sweet, refreshing treat that is a local favourite!

As we explore, nature enthusiasts may spot some of Vietnam's unique wildlife, including the vibrant Orange-breasted Green Pigeon, the spectacular Greater Rackettailed Drongo and the Scarlet-backed Flowerpecker. With its blend of historical grandeur, stunning landscapes, and peaceful ambiance, My Son offers an exceptional experience for both photographers and history lovers alike.

After our visit, we'll head to Da Nang, where you'll check in to your hotel. Once settled, the afternoon is yours to relax and enjoy the beautiful beaches. You can take a swim, grab a light lunch of your choice, or indulge in a refreshing massage or spa treatment. Alternatively, simply unwind in the coastal beauty of Da Nang's beaches at your own pace.

Our main goal is to track down the critically endangered Red-shanked Douc Langur, often referred to as the "most beautiful primate in the world" for its striking colours and human-like faces. As we explore the lush forest, keep an eye out for other fascinating wildlife, including the playful Rhesus Macague, Green-billed Malkoha, Oriental Honey Buzzard, Green-eared Barbet, Pallas' Squirrel, Racket-tailed Treepie and clouds of spectacular tropical butterflies.

After exploring the forest, we will visit the serene Linh Ung Pagoda, a spiritual and architectural marvel nestled on the Son Tra Peninsula. This revered site is home to the towering Lady Buddha statue, one of the tallest of its kind in Vietnam, standing 67 meters high and offering panoramic views of the sweeping coastline and lush hills. The pagoda complex itself is a masterpiece, featuring intricately carved temples, peaceful courtyards adorned with bonsai trees and several collections of grand Buddhist statues. As you stroll through the grounds, take in the rich spiritual significance of the site, which serves as a beacon of faith and protection for fishermen and locals alike.

Afterward, we'll return to Da Nang for a free-choice lunch and a short flight to Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon). Upon arrival, you'll check in to your accommodation and have time to relax and refresh.

In the evening, we'll dive into the vibrant energy of Saigon with a visit to the iconic Ben Thanh Market. Explore its bustling stalls filled with everything from handicrafts to street food and immerse yourself in the lively atmosphere of this cultural hub.
